

Kerry's Story

In 1994, Kerry Weaver was a competitive race walker and a dedicated member of the St. Catharines Roadrunners and Walkers. During her cross training she was run down by an inattentive driver. It was later determined that she had suffered a serious acquired brain injury (ABI). Kerry contacted the Brain Injury Association of Niagara (BIAN), whose knowledge, care and empathy helped Kerry get most of her life back.

“Kerry's Head for the Hills” was created as a collaboration between a running club (SCRWW) and a not-for profit organization (BIAN). It is a race designed to offer an interesting experience to runners and to give back to an organization that had done so much for Kerry.
